HOME SCHOOL TUITION RATES

Upon acceptance, home schooled children in grades 6-12 may enroll in one or more PMCA courses. The cost per class is determined by dividing the total annual tuition by seven.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

Three tuition payment options (Annual, Semester and Monthly) are available for your convenience.

- Annual payments can be made directly to the PMCA Business Office no later than August 2, 2010.
- Semester payments are made August 5 and January 5 via FACTS Tuition Management.
- Monthly payments are made July through May via FACTS Tuition Management.

DISCOUNTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS*

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT

Families with more than one child enrolled in Full-Day Kindergarten through twelfth grade receive a 5% discount off their second child's tuition and a 15% discount off their third child's tuition. Additional children receive a 25% discount.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

PMCA offers two scholarships in recognition of alumni and pastors. These scholarships are available to full-time students. Please note that in the event that your family qualifies for both scholarship programs, only one will be applied.

1. ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

In recognition of the commitment of our alumni and their families to Christian education, PMCA offers the children of our graduates a \$1,000 per child scholarship.

2. PASTORAL SCHOLARSHIP

In support of church leaders, a \$2,000 per child scholarship is available for families where the father is a full-time head, associate, or youth pastor. A divinity degree is required.

* Part-time and International students are not eligible to receive financial aid, discounts, scholarships or Welcome Rewards.

NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM

To receive consideration for financial assistance, you are welcome to complete a FACTS Grant & AID Assessment Application (www.factstuitionaid.com) at a cost of \$25. The Financial Aid Committee assesses applications on an annual and case-by-case basis and awards assistance to families based on need, income, number of full time students a family is enrolling in PMCA, and the amount PMCA has available for aid. Admission decisions are made separately from financial aid decisions to maintain the integrity of our admissions process.

Donors are encouraged to support PMCA's Financial Aid Program through the Annual Fund, which provides financial assistance to families who demonstrate need.
