GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

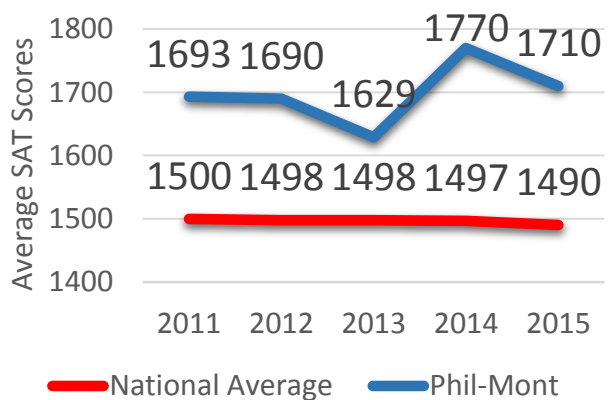
